The student will benefit through this program by gaining a relevant understanding for the relationship of school to future jobs. The program will provide a realistic perspective of work habits and attitudes along with helping to determine the suitability of occupational and educational selections.

This program will promote positive community public relations and will provide the employer with prospective employees who can demonstrate improved work attitudes and realistic job expectations. Job Shadowing will stress employability skills and help our young people acquire information that will aid them in their decision making.

All Job Shadowing sites must receive the approval of the program coordinator and the school administration. Parents, Teacher, and Tech Prep team must all approve the job shadowing experience. Students involved in the Job Shadowing experience will be excused from school on **Wednesday April 25th, 2012**, their shadowing day.
